INITIATIVE TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES

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THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize a new agreement with Ounce of Prevention Fund to provide Prevention Initiative Training and Technical Assistance to Community Based Organizations offering family services to support the development of children from the prenatal stage to age three at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. Vendor was selected on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 7-2. A written agreement for Vendor's services is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Vendor and no payment shall be made to Vendor prior to the execution of their written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report.
